## THE EFFECT OF KNOWLEDGE LEVEL OF PHARMACY A PATIENTS IN SIDOARJO ABOUT DAGUSIBU EYE DROPS

DAGUSIBU stands for Get, Use, Save, and Discard, or is a drug-aware family movement program initiated by the Indonesian pharmacist association in achieving public understanding and awareness of the correct use of drugs. There are two types of storage and use of eye drops packaging, namely single dose and multi dose. For single dose packaging, it is used no more than three times 24 hours, while for multidose packaging it can be used no more than 30 days after the first use of the package is opened. For disposal of liquid medicinal preparations such as eye drops, it is better for liquid eye drops to be disposed of in a water closet and the label on the package or medicine container be tampered with first and then disposed of in the trash. This research is a quantitative descriptive research with a cross sectional design. Data collection by distributing questionnaires to patients at pharmacy A, questionnaires were distributed to 60 respondents, where the average result of the answers from 60 respondents was that the level of knowledge was 53,3%.
