

ABSTRACT

STUDY OF ADMINISTRATIVE AND PHARMACEUTICAL PRESCRIPTION COMPLETENESS AT BUNDA WARU HOSPITAL, OCTOBER 2022

Prescription review is carried out by a pharmacist to prevent medication errors from occurring. The purpose of this study was to determine the completeness of prescriptions at Bunda Waru Sidoarjo Hospital in accordance with PMK No.74 of 2016. The research conducted was descriptive in nature, with random data collection and observing the prescriptions entered in the October 2022 period written by doctors. Administrative and pharmaceutical studies were carried out on 375 doctor's prescriptions by filling in the data collection table, according to the completeness aspect of the prescription being reviewed. The results showed that the percentage of prescription completeness administratively included 100% doctor's name, 100% doctor's SIP, date of writing prescription 100%, doctor's initials 63%, patient's name 100%, patient's age 0%, gender 0%, patient's address 0%, date of birth 91%. The percentage of pharmaceutical prescription completeness includes 100% drug name, 96% dosage form, 99% directions for use, 91% dosage strength, 100% dosage amount. The conclusion from the results of a study of administrative and pharmaceutical completeness of prescriptions at Bunda Waru Sidoarjo Hospital, out of 375 total prescription sheets, 0% were complete and 100% were incomplete.
