## **ABSTRACT**

## LEVEL OF KNOWLEDGE OF ENGGAL HUSADA PHARMACY PATIENTS ON DAGUSIBU EYE DROPS

Eye drops are sterile preparations used for certain eye conditions. Its use must be correct and sterile to avoid eye problems. The DAGUSIBU (Get, Use, Save, Throw Away) program was held to increase public understanding of drug use. However, there is still a lack of public awareness regarding the use of eye drops. This study aims to evaluate the level of knowledge of patients at Enggal Husada Pharmacy about DAGUSIBU eye drops. This research method is descriptive observational with a cross sectional approach. Data was collected through questionnaires distributed to 60 respondents who met the research criteria. The results show a fairly good level of knowledge, with the majority of respondents being women aged 26-35 years with a bachelor's degree and working as employees. Most respondents had good knowledge about obtaining, using, storing and disposing of eye drops. This shows that outreach efforts such as the DAGUSIBU program are important to increase public awareness of the use of eye drops.
