## **ABSTRACT**

## Distribution Profil of Infusion Preparations in the Warehouse RSPAL Dr. Ramelan Surabaya.

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Distribution of medicines (infusion preparation) is the process of handing over medicines from the time the preparation are prepared by the hospital pharmacy instalation until the medicines are handed over to head workers to be given to patients. Based on research condukted by RSPAL Dr. Ramelan Surabaya from April to may 2024. With the aim of reseach to determine the procurement or control of stock distribution of infusion preparation in pharmaceutical warehauses and to determine the distribution of infusion preparation to depot or unit pharmacy instalation at the RSPAL Dr. Ramelan Surabaya. This research uses the consumtion metod in the period January 2024, for sampling using total sampling and meeting the specified criteria, and the instrumen in this research is a stock card. Data collection techniques for this research in clude direct observation and observing the distribution of drugs in parmaceutical instalation to obtain information according to reality, as. From the results of observations made by researt at the Pharmacy warehouse RSPAL Dr.Ramelan Surabaya, that the ditribution of infusion reparations from the pharmaceutical warehouse is through 8 depots, and the distribution of infusion preparetions whith a percentage of 100% is NS 250 ml is distributed to outpatients and inpatients. Albumin 20 % distributed in the Central ICU depot. Kaen 3B distributed to in patients depots, emergency room, ICUs and Meanwhile, the lowest presentage distribution was acetylestien infusion, the larges use was distribused to the emergensi room depot. This indication of acetyleistien is widely used in patients with acute bronchial respiratory.

The conclusion of this research is the distribution of infusion preparations in the pharmacy warehouse of RSPAL Dr. Ramelan Surabaya has the larges supply of NS 500 ml with a total of 18.440 bottles, where the inpatients depot has the most requests from the pharmacy werehouse and the infusion preparation with the least output is Albumin 20% with a total of 20 bottles, the depot that receives it is the Central ICU depot.
