ABSTRACT

EVALUATION OF MEDICATION STORAGE LASA (LOOK ALIKE SOUND ALIKE) AT K24 REWWIN PHARMACY

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This study aims to evaluate the LASA (Look Alike Sound Alike) drug storage system at K24 Rewwin Pharmacy, which has the potential to pose a risk of medical errors due to similarities in appearance or pronunciation of drug names. This study was carried out using a checklist based on BPOM regulation number 4 of 2018, which regulates drug storage standards in pharmacies. Data was collected through direct observation of drug storage in this pharmacy. The research results show that the majority of LASA drugs are stored in accordance with regulations, although there are several aspects that need to be improved, such as special marking and clearer separation between LASA drugs. In conclusion, the drug storage system at the K24 Rewwin Pharmacy is generally good, but needs improvement to optimize safety and prevent medication administration errors. This research makes an important contribution to increasing awareness and safe medication storage practices in pharmacies.
